 - a. Construction Projects

Bids: Again, we got just one bid for each project, from the same bidder as last time. TK - \$1.9 million, Roof/bathrooms - \$1.3 million. Roof/bathroom bid is "Exorbitant" per Melissa, the Architect. The estimator had expected more like \$1.4 million for the TK.

For the TK building, we just need to have a contract signed by October, we don't have to have the money encumbered or the project started by October.

We can now consider lease-leaseback. Many large contractors will only do lease-leaseback. With lease-leaseback you don't have to pick the lowest bid, instead you can choose the contractor you think will provide the best value. Mr. Rhabyt pointed out that with lease-leaseback the budget is limited and what tends to happen is that the quality is deteriorated to match the budget.

Another option may be to interview contractors and pick that way, because we already went through the bidding process. This would not be lease-leaseback.

In any event we probably need to plan on doing the construction work on both projects in the summer of 2024. Per Melissa, the goal of getting the projects done this summer is a big part of why we got so few bids. The contractors were all already busy for the summer of 2023.
