

Preschool Closure Policy (PESD 215)

It may become necessary for Pacific Preschool to close for a variety of reasons:

- Various emergencies, including fires, storms, or earthquakes that create unsafe conditions at the school or on the roads leading to the school
- A public health order and/or a substantial disease outbreak
- A substantial staffing issue
- Air quality conditions
- Other unforeseen circumstances

In the event that it is necessary for Pacific Preschool to close, the preschool staff will, if possible, offer remote learning options. Pacific Preschool reserves the right to offer distance learning, with no onsite option, for up to 10 days during one school year without offering make-up days and/or tuition refunds. If the preschool is closed for in-person learning more than 10 days in a school year, the school will either offer make-up days and/or tuition refunds for any days closed above and beyond 10.
