California Seatbelt Law

You and all passengers must wear a seat belt or you and/or your passenger(s) may be cited. If the passenger is under 16 years old, you may be cited if they are not wearing their seat belt.

Children must be secured by either a federally-approved child passenger restraint system or a safety belt depending on their height and age.

- Children under 2 years old must be secured in a rear-facing child passenger restraint system unless the child is 40 pounds or more, or 3 feet 4 inches or taller.
- Children under 8 years old, or who are less than 4 feet 9 inches tall, must be properly secured in a federally-approved child passenger restraint system.
- Children under 8 years old may ride in the front seat of a vehicle in a federally-approved child passenger restraint system under the following instances:
 - There is no rear seat.
 - The rear seats are side-facing jump seats.
 - The rear seats are rear-facing seats.
 - The child passenger restraint system cannot be installed properly in the rear seat.
 - All rear seats are already occupied by children 7 years old or younger.
 - Medical reasons require the child to not ride in the back seat.
- A child **may not** ride in the front seat of an airbag equipped vehicle if they are in a rear-facing child passenger restraint system.
- Children who are 8 years old or older OR who have reached at least 4 feet 9 inches in height may use a properly secured safety belt meeting federal standards.

Pacific School Field Trip Driver Policies

Thank you for your willingness to drive on our field trip. When using your car to transport students on behalf of Pacific School please adhere to the following:

- Field trip drivers must safely stop off the road in a parking area or commercial space before engaging in any phone or text-based communications. While hands free devices are legally permissible, Pacific School asks that you refrain from talking on cell phones while driving.
- Check the safety of your vehicle: tires, brakes, lights, horn, seat belts, etc. before the trip. All must be functioning properly.
- There are to be no students in the front seat; all passengers must have a seat belt or car seat if necessary (see above). Siblings and animals are not permitted on school trips.
- Follow the planned route to and from the destination; make no unauthorized stops.
- Do not exceed the posted speed limit

In case of emergency: Keep the children together. Call 911. Then call the school (831-425-7002) for further instructions.
