Student Walk-Bike-Scooter Agreement & Consent Form

This agreement is valid during the _____ school year and must be renewed annually.

In order to ensure the safety of our students, Pacific Elementary School District requires that any student who walks, bikes, or scooters to or from school has a signed Agreement and Consent Form on file *at least 3 days before* the student self-transportation can be approved. Please plan ahead.

Safety Agreements – Students and parents must agree to the following:

- Always be safe, kind, and responsible while traveling to or from school.
- Always look both ways before crossing any street – look left, look right, and look left again before proceeding. Stay alert at all times and pay attention to traffic.
- Do not wear headphones, listen to any devices, or talk on a cell phone, smart watch, or other device while walking, biking, or scootering.
- Never cross or walk, bike, or scooter along Highway 1 for any reason without an adult present.
- Go directly home or to your destination and check in with an adult once you arrive.
- Do not roller skate, roller blade, or skateboard on campus or traveling to or from school.
- If you become ill or injured during school, or if there is a school-wide emergency, a parent, guardian, or authorized emergency contact will need to pick you up. You will not be allowed to walk/bike/scooter home alone.
- Bike/Scooter Rules:
 - Scooters must have handle bars.
 - Bikes/scooters must be powered by human power only – no motors, batteries, e-bikes, etc.
 - Bikes/scooters must be walked, not ridden, while on campus.
 - Bikes/scooters must be in good working condition, including sound brakes and tires.
 - Bikes must be stored in the bike rack while at school. Scooters must be stored in a location stipulated by the office staff.
 - Bike and scooter riders must wear an appropriate helmet that is in good condition at all times.
 - Only one rider is permitted per bike/scooter.

Parent Consent – Parents/guardians are responsible for determining the best and safest route for their student when traveling to or from school.
